Interview Schedule Options

- **Open:** Any CAFNR student interested in and qualified for the position(s) may sign up for a time.
- **Pre-Select:** Students must request an interview and be selected by the employers before being given access to the time slots. This schedule type is recommended only for those employers who have more interested candidates than number of interview slots.

Traveling to Columbia

Columbia is located between Kansas City and St. Louis on Interstate 70 and is 32 miles north of Jefferson City on U.S. Highway 63.

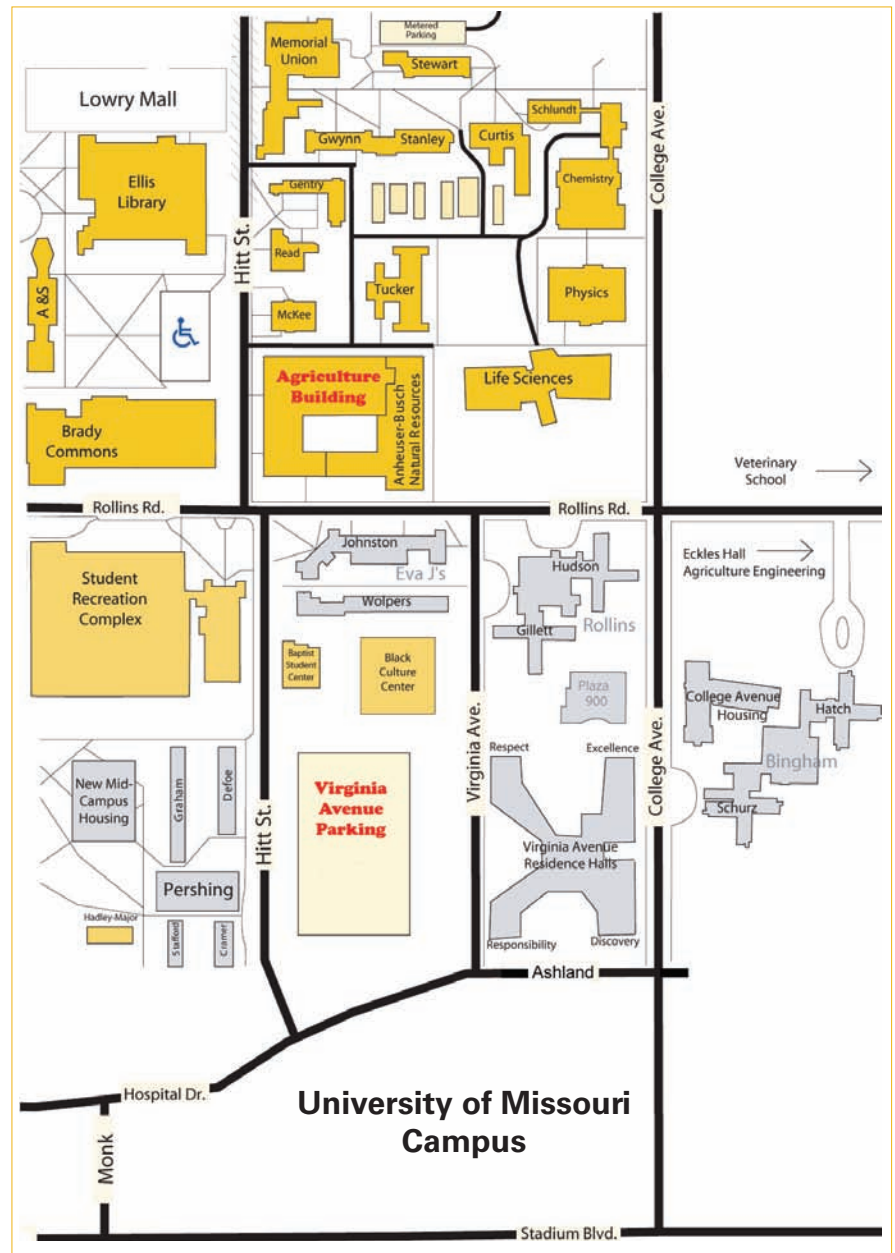
Getting to Campus

If coming into Columbia from the north or south on U.S. Highway 63, take the Stadium Boulevard exit (Missouri Highway 740). Travel west on Stadium Boulevard until you reach College Avenue. Turn onto College Avenue, and after about one-quarter of a mile, make a left at East Rollins Street.

If traveling from the east or west on Interstate 70, take the Missouri Highway 740 Exit (exit 124) onto Stadium Boulevard. Stay on Stadium, driving south until you reach College Avenue (approximately 5 miles). Turn left on College Avenue, and after about one-quarter of a mile, make another left at East Rollins Street.

The Agriculture Building is located at the intersection of East Rollins and Hitt streets. The College of Agriculture, Food and Natural Resources Career Services Office is on the main floor of the Agriculture Building in 2-64.

Visitor parking is available in the Virginia Avenue Garage and in the University Avenue Garage.
